In order that we and our guests can continue enjoying the Lake District, we feel that supporting conservation in the Lake District is vital for the future of this beautiful landscape.

As part of our support we continue to be members of Nurture Lakeland (formerly the Tourism and Conservation Partnership). In particular we are supporting the Fix the Fells project through the 'opt out'

scheme. Guests will be asked if they would like to make a donation to the project at the end of your stay. For every £1 that is donated, the Heritage Lottery Fund will contribute another £2.

According to the Fix the Fells website: "Since 2002 skilled footpath repair teams with the help of hundreds of volunteers have been using both traditional and cutting edge techniques to maintain and repair the Lake District's upland footpaths. With generous funding from the Heritage Lottery Fund and the support of our fantastic partners, we've fixed more than 160 Lake District paths, but at least 60 are still in desperate need of some tender loving care."

The Burn How has been supporting conservation in the Lake District for many years and have raised over £32,000 to conservation projects across the Lake District.
